Dear Mr. Mitchell:

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of December 24, 1953 wherein you withdrew General Construction Department Grievance No. 26-220, R. C. File No. 37, relating to expenses based on a special assignment job.

The interpretation of a special assignment as used in the General Construction Department in carrying out the provisions of Section 301.7 of the Agreement may be stated as follows:

1. Any job away from his established headquarters to which an employee is sent with the expectation that he shall return to such headquarters within a 14 day period.
2. A job of a special temporary nature to which an employee is assigned while en route from one regularly established headquarters to another regular headquarters - such assignment also not to exceed 14 consecutive days.

Employees who are sent on special assignments as indicated are informed in advance of the nature of their assignment.
