Dear Mr. Thompson:

The employees involved in Grievance #6 (San Jose Division), R. C. #69, were employed in clerical classifications which were, subsequent to the grievance, redesignated as physical employees covered by the new physical classification of Foreman's Clerk.

The schedule of hours for these particular jobs is thus covered by provisions of the Physical Agreement and has been resolved as a result of local agreement under that Contract.

The specific claim for allowable deviations made by the San Jose Division in their interpretation of the Clerical Agreement is still at issue. However, in view of the re-designation of the clerical employees, over which the issue was raised, and the elimination of the dispute as it relates to these specific jobs, the Union is withdrawing R. C. #69 from the active list of Review Cases, with the understanding that in so doing, we do not prejudice the processing of other cases bearing on the issue.
