THE CANCELLATION OF JOB VACANCY 12:149 IN COLGATE DIVISION HAS REMOVED THE IMMEDIATE QUESTION ON THIS ISSUE. THE RESULTS OF JOB DEFINITIONS AND LINES OF PROGRESSION NEGOTIATIONS, AS THEY RELATE TO THE ELECTRICAL TECHNICIAN CLASSIFICATION, SHOULD PROVIDE A MORE FAVORABLE SITUATION FOR BOTH PARTIES IN CONNECTION WITH FUTURE SITUATIONS OF THIS SAME NATURE.

THEREFORE, UNION IS WITHDRAWING THIS PARTICULAR CASE AND YOU CAN CONSIDER R.C. FILE #150 CLOSED.
