The above subject grievances are being returned to the Stockton Division Joint Grievance Committee for further consideration and settlement.

The grievances should be settled in accord with our letter of April 25, 1961, "Modification of Job Classification and Lines of Progression in Division Warehouse Departments".

The facts submitted to the Review Committee indicate that the Warehousemen concerned in these grievances were working alone. Company and Union have agreed that an employee performing night loading alone shall be classified as a Warehouseman.

The record submitted to the Review Committee is not clear, however, as to the work performed by grievants when they performed work at night. The Union indicates that, in addition to the loading and unloading of materials, they performed routine warehouse work in that they supplied material to crews called out on emergency work, received materials delivered by contract truckers, and completed the day's paper work.

The Company and Union have agreed that the deviations from normal hours shall be limited to work which cannot be performed during the regular hours, as provided in Section 202.15, namely, the loading and unloading of materials on Company trucks, or working on salvage material. Therefore, if your investigation reveals that the grievants are assigned work other than as provided, such assignments should be discontinued.
