
Re: Grievance of John B. Osborne

Re: Grievance of John B. Osborne

Gentlemen:

In accordance with prior conversations, this is to certify that the grievance now being processed by Local 1245 of the IBEW under the Collective Bargaining Agreement with your Company involving a claim for reimbursement of lost time by myself between February 5th, 1960 and April 4th, 1960, has been settled under the following terms and conditions. The parties have agreed that certain Stipulations will be presented to the Industrial Accident Commission of the State of California in Case No. 60 SF 192-246 by which Stipulations I am to receive temporary disability and supplemental benefits during the above period of time, less certain periods during which I worked at other employment. It is my understanding that the Stipulations will be forwarded to the Industrial Accident Commission, and as soon as the Commission has issued an Order in exact accordance to the terms of the Stipulations, all parties may conclude that the grievance has been satisfactorily settled.
