Please be advised that the Union is hereby withdrawing R.C. #260 (DeSaba Division Grievance #71) from the Review file.

The incident giving rise to the filing of R.C. #260 ceased to exist shortly after the issue was raised by the grievance. The correction sought was the elimination of the utilization of the Groundmen on the prefabrication crew. The practice did cease to exist and to our knowledge has not arisen to this date.

While we are withdrawing this case and will consider it closed, we do so without prejudice should the situation mentioned in this grievance be re-established.
