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The application of the "Hours" Clarification to R. C. #273 would have provided a settlement based on the position of the Union and could have been resolved within the Division had the clarification been available for use at the time of this incident.

This case raises the question of vacation relief. In order to make the Union's position clear on this matter, we state the following: While it is not expressly stated in the Clarification of Title 201, the principle of assuming the regular schedule of the person being relieved for the entire period of absence is applicable and is applied in the same manner as outlined in the Agreement on Section 206.20, "Emergency Relief Operators".

We are withdrawing this case from the file in accord with our agreement of retroactive application of the Clarification of Title 201. It will be considered closed with the above understanding and without prejudice to future cases of this kind.
