Dear Mr. Thompson:

The issue in R. C. #381 (De Sabla Division Grievance #86) has been answered by our recent agreement on the Division Clerical Lines of Progression. Insamuch as we have used the negotiating process to resolve a long-standing dispute over the question, we are in agreement that the result of our efforts should be used to resolve this grievance. We consider the action of the Division proper and will close this case.

In relating this decision based on the line of progression to the recent changes in the Clerical Agreement, there is a conflict in intent and the literal language of the two documents involved. This matter, it is understood, shall be resolved by an amendment to the Lines of Progression regarding the wage rate to be paid the Meter Reader and a letter of clarification on Section 13.3 of the Clerical Agreement.
