San Joaquin Division Grievance No. 25-191

Subject of the Grievance

The grievance concerns an employee who was suspended from work without pay for the period commencing November 27, 1962, and ending upon his return to work on December 6, 1962. The correction sought is that the employee be paid for the period that he was suspended.

Discussion

Subsequent to the filing of this grievance, the employee was discharged for reasons other than the matter concerned in this grievance. A grievance concerning this discharge has been withdrawn. It is the decision of the Review Committee that the grievance concerning the suspension will be settled without prejudice to the positions of either Company or Union.

Decision

The grievant shall be paid for the days suspended which he might otherwise have been regularly scheduled to work from November 27, 1962 to December 6, 1962.
