This case involves a question of accumulating the anniversary date for vacation purposes of a General Construction employee who transferred from one Division to another. This issue has been presented for Review to the Review Committee by an appeal to arbitration which was conducted on January 11, 1968, subsequent to the filing of this grievance.
