

1. A method of determining the relative humidity of a gas mixture, comprising the steps of: (a) measuring the total pressure of the gas mixture; (b) measuring the partial pressure of the water vapor in the gas mixture; and (c) calculating the relative humidity from the ratio of the partial pressure of the water vapor to the total pressure of the gas mixture.
