

This case is withdrawn from the active Review file and Union will consider it closed.

The issue in dispute in R. C. 475 is not actually existent in this grievance as the man did not perform the grounding function without assistance. The question involving the use of non-employees was answered by the Division and the issue referred to the Review Committee was based on a hypothetical problem.

Inasmuch as no actual incident has occurred and the determination requested is dependent on a fact situation, Union is withdrawing this case.
