**Review Case #484  
San Jose Division Grievance #8-63-3**

**The problem of safety raised by R. C. #484 has been answered by issuance of a procedure to be followed in washing energized circuits from a steel tower. The conflict between rules involving climbing or working clearances and the washing distances, has been clarified in the letter of instructions and it is our understanding this apparent conflict will be corrected in the rule book.**

**Inasmuch as the issues have been answered through the issuance of the letter of instructions, we feel the matter is resolved. We therefore are withdrawing R. C. #484 from the active file and will consider the grievance closed.**
