Dear Mr. Brown:

Reference is made to Review Committee File #518 (North Bay Division Grievance #4-63-16).

Section 18.6 of the Clerical Agreement has been a matter of controversy in previous cases before the Review Committee. One such dispute was submitted to arbitration in an effort to clarify its use. In the arbitrator's determination of that case, he avoided any comment on Section 18.6 and made his ruling on another basis.

The question of the use of Section 18.6 in that case is still at issue between the parties and any attempt at clarification now would of necessity bring the whole issue before this Committee again. The parties could not resolve the dispute at that time through the grievance procedure and the question raised now only compounds the problem. We believe the question of clarification might better be handled through other channels of the Company-Union relationship.

The complaint in this grievance involved an action which did not take place and the subsequent filling of the vacancy did not constitute a violation of the Agreement. Therefore, we are closing this case by withdrawing it from the active file without commenting on the scope or use of Section 18.6 of the Clerical Agreement.
