

Gentlemen:

Union recently submitted Review Committee Case No. 605, concerning the award of an Equipment Mechanic job in San Rafael, to arbitration. Since then, Company and Union have agreed to close the case as follows:

- 1. Mr. L. Millsap will be offered the opportunity to complete the necessary portions of the apprentice training program to qualify him to perform automotive equipment work.
- 2. If Mr. Millsap declines the above offer, he will be continued in his present classification, but will not be considered for appointment to another Equipment Mechanic classification at any other head-quarters or to a temporary upgrade or appointment to a vacancy in a classification higher in the Line of Progression to Equipment Mechanic.
- 3. Apprentice Equipment Mechanics at the San Rafael headquarters will be given rotational assignment in the tool repair function as provided in the Apprentice Equipment Mechanic Training Program.

If you are in accord with the foregoing and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to Company.
