Dear Mr. Brown:

Reference is made to Review Committee File No. 636 (Sacramento Division Grievance No. 6-65-2). The collateral matter of the application of the Workmen's Compensation and Insurance Chapters of the State Labor Code raised by R. C. #636 is not specifically covered by the Contract and cannot be resolved as a matter of grievance. The Union is withdrawing the case from the active file and considers this issue in the case as one which must be resolved by the appropriate regulatory body responsible for administration of the State Labor Code.

We withdraw the case with the understanding that if a claim is filed with the Industrial Accident Commission and should a ruling be given which places the grievant under industrial compensation from PG&E, the case can be reopened and no prejudice shall result from this withdrawal.
