The above subject grievance was referred to the Review Committee on August 20, 1965. It is returned to your Committee for discussion and disposition in accordance with the following:

The record evidences that the grievants performed work on cables which would be energized at more than 750 volts. The assignment was improper and like work assignments should not be given in the future to employees classified as Underground Electricians.

The employees concerned in this grievance, who performed this work, should be paid for such time at the Cable Splicer rate in effect at that time.

It is further understood that there are no other grievances filed with reference to such work assignments. In this instance, then, grievances concerning such assignments occurring before April 13, 1967, shall not be subject to adjustment under the provisions of the grievance procedure.
