The above subject grievance was referred to the Review Committee on January 25, 1966. The grievance presents two questions relative to his bid from Groundman to Lineman, only one of which, however, is relevant to the disposition of Mr. Munson's grievance. That question concerns his present right, if any, under the provisions of Section 206.9.

The record evidences that he was demoted from Troubleman to Lineman on November 15, 1960. He subsequently bid from Lineman to Labor Foreman and was later demoted from that position to Groundman. Under the facts presented, as he was not demoted from Lineman to Groundman, his bid to Lineman is not entitled to preferential consideration under the provisions of Section 206.9.

Inasmuch, then, as his bid as a Groundman to a Lineman vacancy is not entitled to preferential consideration, under the provisions of Section 206.9, and as the vacancy will apparently be awarded to another, the question presented pertaining to apprentice tests is most and an answer unnecessary to the disposition of this grievance.

Mr. Munson's grievance is denied and this case considered closed. It should be so noted in the minutes of your next Joint Grievance Committee meeting.
