Denial of Overtime Work

The above-subject grievance was forwarded to the Review Committee on March 30, 1966. Since then two aspects of the case have been discussed with the department and resolved.

The first concerned the assignment of overtime work and the provisions of Section 12.4, i.e., overtime work shall be distributed among employees within a department as equally as practicable.

The second concerned a suspicioned abuse of the sick leave provisions of the Labor Agreement. Where there is reason to question an employee's request for sick pay, the provisions of Section 7.7 provide the procedure to be followed.

This case is closed and should be so noted in the minutes of your next Joint Grievance Committee meeting.
