The applicable wage rate for each such assignment shall be determined in accordance with the provisions of Section 204.5 of the Physical Agreement.

The applicable wage rate for each such assignment shall be determined in accordance with the provisions of Section 204.5.

Start	-	\$181.55	per week
End 6 Mos.	-	\$186.40	" "
End 1 Yr.	-	\$191.30	" "
End 18 Mos.	-	\$196.20	" "

It is further agreed and understood that the foregoing wage rates shall become applicable on the execution of this letter agreement.
