The Review Committee has discussed the above subject grievance and is returning it to the Division Joint Grievance Committee for further discussion and settlement in accordance with the following:

The crux of the dispute, notwithstanding the issues raised locally, seems to be the calling out of the second Troubleman rather than a line crew. In the 12 kv incident, two Troublemens were called out initially for the purpose of locating the trouble - then later combined to install temporary jumpers. This was not improper. In contrast to this, if the second Troubleman had been called to make permanent repairs, this would be improper. In that situation, a line crew should be called.

This case is considered closed without prejudice to the position of either the Company or Union and should be so noted in the minutes of the next Joint Grievance Committee meeting.
