Application of Title 13 Upon Transfer to
Beginning Job in Another Bargaining Unit

This grievance has been discussed by the Review Committee as it is affected by the recently signed Labor Agreement Interpretation on "Continuing Grievances" and the letter agreement on "Crossing Bargaining Unit Lines." The grievance is being returned to the Joint Grievance Committee for further discussion and disposition in accordance with the following:

Under the above-mentioned Labor Agreement Interpretation and letter agreement, the grievant is entitled to a retroactive wage adjustment. Inasmuch as the grievance was filed within 30 days of the incident, the retroactive wage adjustment should be effective on May 27, 1968, the actual date of the grievant's transfer to the new line of progression.

The Division should prepare the necessary authorization granting a retroactive wage adjustment for the period beginning on May 27, 1968 and ending November 25, 1968, when the grievant was promoted to Clerk C. The wage adjustment should be calculated as if the grievant had been placed in the 24-month step of the wage progression and he should be paid the difference between the 24-month step and what he actually received for this period. This step reflects six months' credit for time worked at the top of Helper and six months' credit for temporary assignments in the new classification.

Following discussion and completion of the above, this case will be considered closed and should be so noted in the minutes of the next Joint Grievance Committee meeting.
