This grievance has been discussed by the Review Committee as it is affected by the recently signed Labor Agreement Interpretation on "Continuing Grievances" and letter agreement on "Crossing Bargaining Unit Lines." The grievance is being returned to the Local Investigating Committee for further discussion and disposition in accordance with the following:

The new Labor Agreement Interpretation and letter agreement provide the grievant coverage under Subsection 13.9(a) of the Clerical Agreement and as a result, the grievant is entitled to a retroactive wage adjustment.

The Division should prepare the necessary authorization granting the retroactive wage adjustment for the period beginning on October 16, 1968 and ending on the date the grievant was promoted to Clerk C. The wage adjustment should be calculated as if the grievant had been placed in the 18-month step on October 16, 1968, which includes six months' credit for time spent at the top of Helper. He should be paid the difference between the 18-month step and what he actually received during this period.

Following discussion and completion of the above, this case will be considered closed.
