The above-subject grievance has been discussed at recent meetings of the Review Committee.

The record submitted to the Review Committee makes it clear that the employee had performed the two-man unit insulator washing on two different occasions before his refusal on July 13. It is also clear from the record that the employee was sufficiently put on notice of the consequences of his refusal. The record further states that he unconditionally agreed to return to work and that he would perform the same type of work in the future.

On the basis of the record before the Review Committee, it is the Committee's decision that this file shall be considered closed without prejudice to the position of either Company or Union.

The Review Committee's action should be noted in the next minutes of your next Joint Grievance Committee meeting.
