REVIEW COMMITTEE DECISION NO. 1828

Arbitration Case No. 237 resolved eight grievances concerning the opening of replacement paystations. It also addressed the question of opening new paystations.

Arbitrator Silbert found no violation of the agreement in either situation. While these eight grievances were being processed through arbitration, several more cases were held at the Review Committee step pending the outcome of the arbitration.

Based on the arbitration settlement, the Review Committee agrees to close the following cases without adjustment on the basis that no contractual violation occurred:
