The following two applications of Title 206 have recently been agreed to by PG&E and Local 1245.

1) Consistent with classifications that have automatic progression and are not subject to bidding under Title 205, Assistant Operator and Operator-In-Training shall be treated as the same classification..

2) An 206.3 "on paper" option may only be used if there are no next lower classifications at the headquarters of the involved employee.

For example, the classification of Apprentice Fitter has five classifications that are listed as next lower. If any of the five classifications are at the headquarters of the Apprentice Fitter to be demoted, then such employee's 206.3 options would be limited to the classifications at the headquarters. If there are not any of the five jobs at the headquarters, the employee may then demote "on paper" to a lower classification and then consider the resulting 206.4 option.
