Hearing on Salary, Benefits and Working Conditions for Faculty, Staff, and Students at Sonoma State University

The North Bay Workers' Rights Board (WRB) is a public forum where workers can bring complaints against employers and institutions for violating their human and legal rights and expectations of fair treatment at the workplace.

Sonoma State University (SSU) is one of the 23 campuses of the California State University (CSU) System. More than 9400 students attend SSU, which employs 1500 faculty and staff. Just over 600 SSU employees are faculty, represented by the California Faculty Association (CFA). Despite months of negotiation, the CFA has been unable to resolve several salary and workplace issues with the CSU administration.

Noncompetitive pay, growing reliance on temporary instructors, and increasing class sizes have undermined the quality of the education that SSU provides to students in the North Bay.
