Dear Mr. Dalzell:

The Company consolidated Electric Distribution Operations from 13 legacy Control Centers into three Electric Distribution Control Centers (DCC's). Letters of Agreement 13-19-PGE and 15-49-PGE established provisions for the retention of employees headquartered in the legacy Control Centers and their transition into the DCC's. Among those provisions was the opportunity for displaced employees to defer their Section 206.7 severance until the end of their specified retention period.

In Letter of Agreement 17-36-PGE, the Company and Union agreed to allow employees the opportunity to voluntarily continue deferring their severance no later than March 31, 2020, as outlined in previous Letters of Agreement 13-19-PGE and 15-49-PGE.

For employee severance dates that occur after January 29, 2019, under Letter of Agreement 17-36-PGE, the Company and the Union agree that the specific terms of Letter of Agreement 17-36-PGE are intended to supersede any requirements under SB901 triggered by PG&E's filing of a petition for Chapter 11 bankruptcy.
