Dear Mr. Dean:

The Company and Union entered into Letter Agreement 20-39 which identified steps the Company has taken to ensure that emergency and critical work continues during the COVID-19 health crisis. Specifically, the Company and Union agreed to seek employee volunteers in Electric, Gas and Generation operations to remain sequestered at onsite work locations, if needed. The purpose of sequestration is to promote worker health and safety while maintaining critical infrastructure operations during the COVID-19 health crisis.

In Letter Agreement 20-68, the terms of 20-39 were extended through March 31, 2021. In Letter Agreement 21-11, the terms of 20-39 were extended again through December 31, 2021. The parties have discussed the Company's continued need to prepare for, and/or continue possible sequestrations; therefore, the parties agree that Letter Agreement 20-39 will be extended, under the same terms and conditions, to December 31, 2022.

This agreement may be extended by mutual written agreement of the parties.
