

#### THE JOB

We are seeking a Journeyman Lineman with integrity and a strong work ethic; Candidate should have at least one year working experience upon completion of a City and IBEW approved apprenticeship. Duties include constructing and maintaining all aspects of Distribution and Transmission electrical systems.
