Re: Arbitration No. 58

Reference is made to our conversation Thursday concerning our proposed settlement of the above-subject arbitration case.

In consideration of Union's closing the case without necessity to resort to arbitration, as I indicated, the Company will pay the arbitrator's minimum fee and will establish a Maintenance Subforeman position in each of the Divisions involved. Pursuant to Section 205.19 of the current Agreement, the positions will be offered to the senior qualified employee in each of the Divisions applicable line of progression to such a vacancy. The appointments will be effective March 1, 1976.

We have informed Mr. Eaton that the matter has been resolved and the hearing scheduled to commence February 25 cancelled.
