Subject of the Grievance:

Agency workers performing work in violation of Arbitration Case No. 142.

Facts of the Case:

During the outages at Diablo Canyon in 1988, the Company used agency workers to perform technician work. These workers performed pre-outage and post-outage work with little break in service between Unit 1 and Unit 2 outages.

Since the grievance, the Company and Union have changed the language in the Agreement concerning the use of agency workers as well as entered in an "Outage Worker Agreement" at Diablo Canyon. Both agreements cover and resolve the issue in these grievances.

Discussion and Disposition:

The Committee agrees that since agreements have been reached for the hiring of additional workers for outages at Diablo Canyon and given the age of the grievances, that these cases be closed without adjustment and without prejudice.
