Operator, Compressor

1570 A - air compressor or multiple compressors over 1,000 cu. ft. actual output.

1573 B - air compressor or multiple compressors supplying 330 to 1,000 cu. ft., inclusive, actual output.

1594 - Operator, Crane

Crane - 40-70 ton capacity such as the Lima, 40 ton; the Link Belt, 45 ton; the American, 50 ton; the Lima, 70 ton.

Crane - 30-35 ton capacity such as PMH 30 ton and 35 ton and the Calavar Lift.

Crane - All 10-25 ton capacity such as Grove 12 ton, Bucyrus Erie 15 ton and the Lorain 20 ton.

Pile Driving Hammer - Such as Kobe Mod. K13, diesel powered when applicable or equivalent.

1596 - Operator, Crane - Service Center, Davis

- 1643 B - Earthworm;

 Concrete Mixers 1/2 cu. yd. and under;
 Concrete saws;
 Tractor P.T. Loader less than 1-1/2 cu. yd. with or without scraper;
 Compactors, self-propelled, riding such as:
 Arrow Hydra-Hammer/compactor, Champion Stroke hammer, OHawa Hydra-Hammer/tamper, R & O Hydra-Hammer/compactor, Superhammer/compactor, or equal;
 Tugger Air Hoist;
 Air compressor under 330 C.F.M.;
 Riding roller (self-propelled);
 Street Sweeper (self-propelled);

 Or equivalent.

- 1644 C - Operates such equipment as small tiller type tractor or similar hauling unit; industrial material handling truck or tractor including life and towing; pump tender, pneumatic paving breakers, spades and tampers, or equivalent.

1690 - Operator, Holediggers

Operator, Mixer

- 1710 A - concrete mixer 2 cu. yd. or over output.
- 1713 B - concrete mixer 1 cu. yd. or more and less than 2 cu. yd. output.
- 1714 C - concrete mixer of more than 1/2 cu. yd. and less than 1 cu. yd. output.

Operator, Tractor

- 1840 A - Cat D-6, D-7 and D-8; AC HD-11, HD-16 and HD-21; JHTD-15, TD-20 and TD-25; or equal. Motor Patrol over 115 HP or when grading to stakes or grade: Tractor, crawler side boom, 10 ton and over. Drott 18 ton or equivalent.
- 1843 B - Cat D-4 and D-5; Case 850 and 1150, ACHD-6, IHTD-9; or equal, Drott over 5 ton to and including 15 ton; Crane, swing self-propelled 5 to 10 ton P/M Mod 25-20 Loader, crawler mounted, 1-1/2 cu. yds. and over; Whirley, Swing crane or equivalent.
- 1844 C - Smaller than a D-4 or equivalent with or without equipment.

1860 - Operator, Trencher

Large wheel and ladder type trenchers such as Barbe-Green, Parsons, Cleveland, Gauwood, Challenge, or equivalent.

Operator, Backhoe

All Backhoes - includes truck-mounted Warner-Swaswy Gradall, Mod. G 660; Crawler mounted Hein-Werner Hyd. Backhoe/Excavator, Mod. C 14A. (Backhoe Operator is considered a specialist and not an integral part of crew.)

Operator, Batch Plant

Governed by size of loader required.

0444 - Truck Driver

The operator of a two-axle truck of 12,000 lb GVW or over.

0453 - Heavy Truck Driver

1. The operator of a truck tractor coupled with one or more trailers; or
2. The operator of a three-axle truck; or
3. The operator of any combination of truck and trailers exceeding 50 feet in length. (Single-axle pole or pipe dollies are not considered trailers for the purposes of the above); or
4. The operator of a truck with derrick and special body complete with tools and equipment to perform all phases of underground electric line work; or
5. The operator of a boom truck with a basic boom tip height of 45 feet or under and with a personnel bucket. (Such as R.O. Stinger TC 50 - TC 40 - TC 35.)

0457 - Line Truck Driver

The operator of a line truck with derrick and special body complete with tools and auxiliary equipment to perform all phases of overhead line work.

0435 - Special Driver

1. The operator of a transport truck and trailer engaged in loading, transporting, and unloading heavy construction equipment throughout the company system; or
2. The operator of a boom truck with a basic boom tip height of over 45 feet, and with a personnel bucket. (Such as Tel-e-lect.)
