SAN JOAQUIN VALLEY REGION GRIEVANCE NO. YOS-91-1 FACT FINDING NO. 5004-91-104 MEMORANDUM OF DISPOSITION

Subject of the Grievance

This grievance concerns whether a bargaining unit Crew Foreman should be required to fill out a performance appraisal on other bargaining unit employees.

The correction requested by the Union was that the Company immediately cease and desist having bargaining unit employees fill out a performance appraisal on another bargaining unit employee.

Discussion

The Committee discussed the need for performance feedback for all employees. The appraisal is necessary from a safety standpoint and is extremely beneficial from a training standpoint as well. The supervisor is not with the crew at all times and must depend on the working member, in most cases the Crew Foreman, to provide information on performance that takes place on a daily basis.

The Committee discussed the manner in which performance appraisals are performed in some of the other areas of the Company.

DECISION

The Committee agreed that there is the need for appraising the performance of all employees in order to give positive feedback on good performance and to improve the performance of others, when appropriate. The Committee further agreed that a supervisor may request input from the Crew Foreman but will fill out the performance review form and review the performance with that employee. In addition, bargaining unit Crew Foremen will not be required to complete performance appraisal docements or conduct performance appraisal meetings. The Committee agreed that there is no intent to consider Crew Foremen as supervisors under the National Labor Relations Act by having the Crew Foreman provide performance information on his crew members.

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On this basis, the case is closed.
