Dear Mr. McNally:

John Davidson is a Gas Service Representative headquartered in Sanger. In early 1999 Mr. Davidison sustained industrial injuries as the result of an automobile accident in which a third party collided with his PG&E service vehicle. He was recently precluded from returning to his normal classification and as a result the Company has been attempting to identify alternate placement opportunities.

The Company proposes the following placement pursuant to Section 205.19. The placement proposal is that Service Operator, Gerald D. Beasley, in Fresno has expressed a willingness to work in Sanger as a Gas Service Representative. Davidson has expressed a willingness and is physically capable of working as a Service Operator in Fresno. Both Beasley and Davidson are the number two pre-bidders to these jobs. The local supervisors and Business Representative, Jim Lynn, have confirmed that the top bidders support the proposal to "swap" Beasley and Davidson.
