Dear Mr. McNally:

On August 31, 2000 the critical status of the Operators at De Anza Control Center expired. Company proposes extending the critical status at this headquarters to December 31, 2001.

The department has 3 vacant positions, 2 of which are on Medical Leave of Absence and most likely will not return, 5 System Operators and 1 Assistant Operator. The System Operators who currently have time remaining on their critical status, or whose critical status expired on August 31, 2000, will have until October 1, 2000, to renew their critical status. During that time period the 8% premium will continue. Concurrently during this time period, employees who have not renewed their critical commitment will retain their unrestricted bidding rights. Employees who do not extend their critical status beyond that point will no longer receive the 8% premium.

Company also proposes that any new employees bidding or transferring into the department will be designated as critical. These new employees would receive critical status for the remainder of the proposed critical period, rather than having the full three year commitment.

This has been discussed with Business Representative Bill Brill.
