Dear Mr. Zimmerman:

In recognition of the recent disasters which took place at the New York City World Trade Center, Washington D.C., and Pennsylvania on September 11, 2001, the Company proposes to amend the provisions of Section 111.15 of the Physical Agreement and Section 8.15 of the Clerical Agreement. This amendment will allow employees to voluntarily sell up to five days of their vacation and transfer the proceeds to the American Red Cross for their Disaster Relief Fund. Employees who choose to make this donation will have their donated vacation days converted to cash and sent directly to the Red Cross. This amendment will be effective through October 12, 2001.
