Dear Mr. Zimmerman:

Letter Agreement R1-97-30-PGE proposes the Company and Union establish training locations for Title 300 Garage employees at Oakland, Richmond and Madera (Gregg Sub), with a stipulation that other headquarters may be added by agreement between the parties.

The Company, in an effort to bring on Title 300 Apprentice Equipment Mechanics into the San Jose and San Francisco areas, would like to establish training sites at Edenvale and Martin garages. This proposal will eliminate the need to train the apprentices at Oakland, Madera and Richmond just to transfer them to San Jose and San Francisco upon completion of the program. Currently, these are the most difficult areas to recruit and hire Equipment Mechanics.

Either party may cancel this agreement by providing 30 days written notice. If this agreement is cancelled, apprentices in the program at the time of cancellation will continue at the designated garage until they complete their training.
