Dear Mr. Zimmerman:

Since January 2000, the Company has filled and continues to fill a large number of Meter Reader positions with the transfer and new hire provisions of the Agreement. Item five, "Conversions of Hiring Hall Meter Reader positions to Regular Status", of the October 27, 1999, Cover Letter to the Agreement, allows for 15% of the Meter Reader positions be filled with Hiring Hall employees.

On May 5, 2001, the parties agreed to Letter Agreement 01-09-PGE, "Hiring Hall Process and Procedures." The parties did not intend to change what was previously agreed to for Meter Readers. Meter Readers may work beyond the 12 consecutive month limitation without requesting an extension.
