Dear Mr. Zimmerman:

The parties met on October 21, 2002 at the Diablo Canyon Power Plant to discuss outage work schedules and conditions in the C&RP Department for the 2R11 outage scheduled to begin in February 2003. The following are the understandings that were reached in accordance with Section 202.16 of the Agreement:

- a) Regular day employees and shift employees in day shift pool may be scheduled to Section 202.17 work schedule beginning either at 6:30 a.m. or 6:30 p.m., with a basic workday of 10 hours. Shift employees assigned to shift may volunteer to work the Section 202.17 work schedule. This does not concede the issue raised in Grievance No. 13495.
- b) Employees assigned to the Section 202.17 work schedule may perform routine or emergency work on the running unit without penalty to the Company.
- c) Employees assigned to the 6:30 p.m. shift will receive 3rd shift premium.
- d) A regular employee will be provided the opportunity to work at least as much overtime as a temporary additional or Hiring Hall employee in a comparable classification (Technicians, Decon Specialists and Utility Workers are considered comparable) over the period beginning at the start of the outage to 30 days following the conclusion of the outage. An employee, who does not make himself available for overtime opportunities, either by refusing an offer to work the scheduled overtime or by being absent during the outage for any reason, will forfeit the consideration under this section.
- e) The Company will make all reasonable attempts to maintain a consistent ratio of regular Technicians to Hiring Hall Technicians on the day shift and night crews where specific DCPP knowledge is not required.

If you are in accord with the foregoing and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to the Company.
