Dear Mr. Zimmerman:

Company proposes to amend Title 103 of the Physical Agreement to allow the San Francisco Gas Field Service employees, who do not obtain regular status until December 2002, the opportunity to defer their Floating Holidays to 2003. The opportunity to defer will be applicable to those employees who have not been able to take their Floating Holidays due to operational reasons. Those employees are Kevin Corrigan (██████████4476) and Anthony Brown (██████████9986).

These Floating Holidays will administratively be converted to vacation and must be taken off during 2003. From a scheduling standpoint, any deferred Floating Holidays will be scheduled in accordance with the provisions of Subsection 111.11(a).
