Dear Mr. Zimmerman:

As you are aware, Company will be inspecting for atmospheric corrosion all of its aboveground gas facilities this year utilizing Meter Readers. Through Arbitration Case No. 265, it has been determined that this assignment falls within the job definition of Meter Readers; and through the Department of Transportation, it has been determined that this is covered work and that the Meter Readers must be pre-duty tested.

Based on these determinations, Company proposes adding to the list of covered classifications in Letter Agreement 04-16, Exhibit D, Customer Services – Gas Service, the following:

- Sr. Meter Reader (2782)
- Meter Reader (2785) HH Meter Reader (0075 and 0076)
- Service Representative and Meter Reader (2769)
- Credit Representative and Meter Reader (2770)
- Meter Reader and Utility Clerk (2772)

All provisions of L/A 04-16 that apply to the Pipeline Safety Program shall apply to the above classifications.

If you are in accord with the foregoing, and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to the Company.
