Dear Mr. Zimmerman:

A series of storms is expected to hit the PG&E service territory this holiday weekend. It is expected that in some locations PG&E crews will be scheduled for prearranged overtime during this storm. In conjunction with Company-Union discussions on this issue, the Company proposes to modify the provisions of Titles 208 and 308 to pay Title 200 and 300 gas and electric employees at the double time rate for pre-arranged overtime scheduled in conjunction with this storm.

This letter agreement is without precedent and will be applicable for this weekend only (end of regular work hours on Friday, December 30, 2005 through Monday, January 2, 2006). The normal provisions of the Physical Agreement will apply after January 2, 2006.
