Dear Mr. Dalzell:

Pursuant to Title 3.5 of the Agreement, the Company proposes to modify the residency requirement for a Troubleman in the Cinnabar Service Center for the following reason.

The Company has been unable to fill the above-referenced position either via the transfer process or as an unrestricted (URA) vacancy.

Xavier Campos is willing to accept the position but lives outside the 30-minute radius.

Due to the difficulty in filling this position, the Company proposes to waive the 30-minute residency requirement. If agreed to, he will be expected to maintain his current residence or one equivalent or closer proximity to the Cinnnabar Service Center headquarters. If he fails to do so, he will be removed from the classification.

This proposal has been reviewed with Business Representative Bill Brill. Either the Company or Union may cancel this agreement with 30 days written notice.
