Dear Mr. Dalzell:

This Side Letter Agreement accompanies the Project Labor Agreement ("Agreement") between Black and Veatch and the California State Building and Construction Trades Council and the Contra Costa Building and Construction Trades Council with respect to the Contra Costa Unit 8 Power Project ("Project").

The construction of transmission and distribution lines, outside substations, switchyards, and ground grids for the Project which are directly or indirectly under the control of Pacific Gas & Electric Company ("PG&E") will be performed by contractors who are signatory to a collective bargaining agreement with IBEW Local No. 1245.

The Successorship provisions of the Agreement apply to PG&E and Local No. 1245 with respect to any work which is not performed in accordance with this Side Letter. Any jurisdictional dispute between Local No. 1245 and a Union who is party to the Agreement will be referred to the General Presidents of the Unions involved and the employer for resolution.

PG&E and IBEW Local No. 1245 each represents that it has the authority to enter into this Side Letter Agreement.

Please indicate your concurrence with the foregoing by executing this Side Letter Agreement below and return one executed copy of this letter to the Company.
