Dear Mr. Dalzell:

In Letter Agreement 00-33-PGE, it stated that within a quarter, the Company cannot pay out a recognition award that exceeds \$200. The Company would like to recognize the five control centers that have gone approximately three years without an operating error to highlight areas of excellence. However, the limit of \$200 per quarter would be exceeded in some cases. The Company wants to provide a \$200 gift card to all employees at the five control centers. Company is proposing an exception for those employees who may have already received an award this quarter. This is consistent with our Human Performance and Lean Six Sigma effort around recognizing/rewarding performance.

The Company proposal is one-time application to allow the employees who have received previous awards in the quarter to be allowed to accept this \$200 award. This amount will not be counted against any future recognition awards in which these employees may be eligible within the parameters outlined in the Letter Agreement 00-33-PGE.

Attached is a list of employees eligible for the award and those who have already received an award this quarter.
