Gentlemen:

On or about March 1, 1964, Station B in San Jose will be converted to automatic on an unmanned basis.

At the same time, Metcalf Substation will be changed from an unmanned to a manned station.

Company proposes to establish Metcalf as a Schedule II substation. At a presently unknown date, contingent upon assumption of a portion of Newark Substation Switching Center activities, Metcalf will be reclassified to Schedule I.

Under the provisions of Title 206 of the Agreement, Company proposes to transfer the four First Operators and two Emergency Relief First Operators at Station B to Metcalf Substation at the Schedule II wage rates of \$144.15 and \$147.15 per week, respectively.

If you are in accord with the foregoing proposal and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to Company.
