Gentlemen:

Company has recently completed a resurvey of the duties of the Utilityman classification in the Water Collection Department at Tiger Creek Powerhouse currently held by Mr. Lars Feltre. The wage rate of the present Utilityman classification is \$84.70 per week and is based on the following breakdown: Truck Driver, Heavy 80%; Tractor Driver, Heavy 15%; Flume Repairman 5%. As a result of such survey, Company proposes to re-classify this position to Utility Truck Driver, Heavy.

The proposed job definition and wage rate for this classification are as follows:

UTILITY TRUCK DRIVER, HEAVY - Water Collection Department -
Tiger Creek Powerhouse

An employee who performs the duties of a Truck Driver, Heavy in the Water Collection Department, and, in addition, shall perform the duties of a Flume Repairman and Tractor Driver, Heavy.

This employee shall accrue classification seniority as a Truck Driver, Heavy and shall be upgraded to Tractor Driver, Heavy on a time card basis when driving a heavy tractor.

Wage rate: \$84.20 per week.
