

Gentlemen:

Our proposed letter agreements dated October 20, 1954 and December 28, 1954 relative to operating classifications at Pit No. 1, Pit No. 3, Pit No. 4 and Pit No. 5 Powerhouses and dated January 11, 1955 relative to operating classifications at Tiger Creek Powerhouse, which you have not signed, are hereby withdrawn.

With the completion of Pit No. 4 Powerhouse scheduled for January, 1955, Company wishes to fill the operating jobs next month. Company, therefore, proposes to establish the classifications of First Operator and Second Operator at Pit No. 4 Powerhouse. The proposed wage rates are those currently paid at other Powerhouses of like design, i.e.
