Gentlemen:

The wage rate of \$81.80 per week currently paid to the Utilityman classification at Kerckhoff Powerhouse, now held by Mr. T. J. Richards, was established on the basis of 20% of each of the following classifications: Truck Driver Light, Tractor Driver Light, Painter, Helper, and Second Operator.

Company proposes to increase the wage rate of this classification to \$83.65 per week based upon the following breakdown of duties:

> Mechanic 1/3 of \$88.35 or \$29.45 Truck Driver-L 1/3 of \$81.30 or \$27.10 Tractor Driver-L 1/3 of \$81.30 or \$27.10

> > Utilityman
